 - Fluctuant

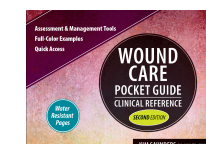

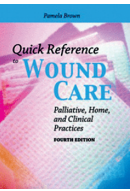

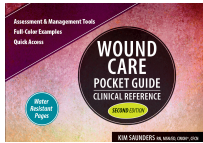
